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WHAT IS EASY ATTENDANT?

Easy Attendant is an attendant receptionist service. When turned on, it answers your calls automatically, and offers your callers a list of options (a “menu”) that you define. You can allow callers to listen to messages, such as your hours of operation (see [Sample Announcements](#) for sample scripts).

DEFINITIONS

Actions: Define the menu choices a caller can make when listening to an announcement.

FOR EXAMPLE: “Press 1 to reach the Sales Department.”

Announcements: The recorded announcement that will play to callers when they dial your telephone number.

Business Group: The account phones programmed for your business.

Menu: Determines what options your callers are offered. You can configure up to eight different menus for your Easy Attendant.

Periods: Define when specific announcements will play (business/out of hours/holiday), etc.

Schedule: Tells the system which announcement and menu to play during the specified time.

Single Menu Mode: One menu is configured to be used during both business and non-business hours.

Special Days: Days outside the normal periods such as holidays, inclement weather days, etc. These can be defined a day at a time, or you can add all public holidays.

Easy Attendant Telephone Number: The telephone number provided by Northland’s System Administrator to log into the Easy Attendant.

GETTING STARTED WITH COMMPORTAL WEB

To set up and/or change your Easy Attendant, login to CommPortal Web.

Login here: <https://bucommportal.northland.net>.

Enter your 10-digit Easy Attendant telephone number and the password provided to you by Northland’s System Administrator. You will be able to change the password later.

This will bring you to the Home screen and Main page of CommPortal Easy Attendant. Your Easy Attendant will be “off” until you have completed recording the announcements.

What you see is determined by whether you are using a single menu or a schedule for business and non-business hours.

By providing an Easy Attendant number and password, you can provide access to the Easy Attendant without providing access to all system programming.

FIRST TIME SETUP SINGLE MENU MODE

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The steps required to enable your Easy Attendant are as follows:

- + Configure the menu callers are offered and the actions they can choose from.
- + Record the announcements that your callers will hear.
- + Manage the extensions your callers can be transferred to.

Your Easy Attendant Single Menu will come pre-configured by Northland's System Administrator with the pre-defined menu you provided on the System Programming Form. You will need to record the actual announcements once you have your system (see [page 5](#) for creating announcements). You will be able to make basic changes in Single Menu Mode, such as changing announcements, the menu or changing to Schedule Mode.

You should have your Easy Attendant announcements documented for ease of recording. (see [Sample Announcements](#)).

NOTE: The Main page of your Easy Attendant single schedule contains tabs for turning the attendant on and off, configuring your Easy Attendant menu, and switching to Schedule Mode.

CONFIGURING SINGLE MENU MODE

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Your Easy Attendant menu configuration determines the options your callers are offered, and what announcements they hear. The menu you provided to Northland Communications during the System Programming process will already be pre-defined in the Easy Attendant. If you have chosen to offer different options during business hours and outside business hours, see [Getting Started in Schedule Mode](#).

The configuration of the Easy Attendant Single Menu Mode consists of the following:

- + Configure the details of what should happen when the caller selects a particular option.
- + Record an initial greeting.
- + Record any announcements that will play when an option is chosen off the menu.

FOR EXAMPLE: Directions.

NOTE: The configuration of details is pre-defined based on the information you provided when you completed the System Programming Form.

To begin, navigate to the Easy Attendant Menu page.

You will see the options you chose already configured.

You can edit or add additional options at any time.

Options 1 – 9 can be configured as follows: 0 is reserved for a receptionist or operator.

Play Announcement:

Transfer the caller to an announcement.

FOR EXAMPLE: Your business hours or directions. When you choose this option, a record option appears next to it. Click **Record** to see record options.

Transfer to Phone: Transfers the call to an extension (individual or group) and follows the path of that extension.

FOR EXAMPLE: If unanswered, the call goes to voicemail. Enter the extension/telephone number in the box to the right. You can choose an internal account phone or you can program an external number such as an answering service.

Transfer to Voicemail: Sends the caller directly to a voicemail without any ringing. Enter the extension/telephone number in the box to the right.

CONFIGURING SINGLE MENU MODE

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Dial by Extension: Callers will be able to dial extension numbers they know.

Dial by Name: If a caller presses this key, they can choose who they want to speak to within the organization by spelling their name using the dial pad. If you assign a key for dial by extension or dial by name, you must also do the following:

- + Define the set of extensions that your callers can be transferred to.
- + Do not attempt to do this until you have finished configuring your menu and have applied the changes.

NOTE: Include appropriate instructions in your menu announcement.

FOR EXAMPLE: "If you know your party's extension, please press 3 and the extension number followed by the pound key." You can further define the extensions callers can dial by going to the Extensions Tab after you have applied your changes to this page (see [Configuring Extensions](#)). When finished, click **Apply**.

CREATING ANNOUNCEMENTS IN SINGLE MENU MODE

+ FROM ANY TELEPHONE

To record announcements from any telephone, you will log into the voicemail system using your Easy Attendant access number and EAS pin, which was provided by Northland's System Administrator.

TO RECORD FROM ANY ACCOUNT PHONE:

- + Press the VM Key or dial *99.
- + If the Mailbox information has been set to Fast Login and/or Skip Pin on the Account Phone you are using, press * to enter the Easy Attendant access number and pin.
- + Enter your Easy Attendant access number and press #.
- + Enter the EAS Pin and press #.

NOTE: The first time you log on, you will be prompted to change your EAS Pin.

- + Press 1 to change your Easy Attendant Configuration (turn on/off).
 - + Press 2 to edit announcements. System advises which announcements are not recorded.
 - + Follow the voice prompts to select which announcement to record.
 - + Begin recording at the tone.
 - + When finished recording, press # and the recording will play back.
 - + Press 1 to save the recording.
 - + Press 2 to re-record.
 - + Press 3 to exit without saving changes.
 - + Press 4 to continue recording where you left off.

When finished with all recordings, turn on your Easy Attendant:

- + Press * to return to the Main Menu.
- + Press 1 to turn on the Easy Attendant.

NOTE: If you hung up before turning the Attendant on, return to the main page of CommPortal Easy Attendant to turn your Easy Attendant on (see [Turning Your Easy Attendant On/Off](#)).

CREATING ANNOUNCEMENTS IN SINGLE MENU MODE

+ FROM ANY TELEPHONE

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TO RECORD FROM ANY EXTERNAL TELEPHONE:

- + Dial (315) 671-0031.
- + Enter the Easy Attendant access number and press #.
- + Enter the EAS Pin and press #.

NOTE: The first time you log on, you will be prompted to change your EAS Pin.

- + Press 1 to change your Easy Attendant Configuration (turn on/off).
 - + Press 2 to edit announcements. System advises which announcements are not recorded.
 - + Follow the voice prompts to select which announcement to record.
 - + Begin recording at the tone.
 - + When finished recording, press # and the recording will play back.
 - + Press 1 to save the recording.
 - + Press 2 to re-record.
 - + Press 3 to exit without saving changes.
 - + Press 4 to continue recording where you left off.

When finished with all recordings, turn on your Easy Attendant:

- + Press * to return to the Main Menu.
- + Press 1 to turn on the Easy Attendant.

NOTE: If you hung up before turning the Attendant on, return to the main page of CommPortal Easy Attendant to turn your Easy Attendant on (see [Turning Your Easy Attendant On/Off](#)).

CREATING ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR SINGLE MENU

+ FROM ANY DEVICE USING COMMPORTAL



Your initial greeting is the first thing callers will hear when the Easy Attendant answers.

You can choose to use a pre-recorded announcement or create a new one. From the Home page, select the Easy Attendant Tab. This will bring you to the Menu/Announcements page.

To the left, you will see the menu you chose when you completed the System Programming Form. If you have chosen for callers to go to an announcement, you will need to record the announcement and will see a Record link next to that choice.

On the right, you will see a sample announcement and a **Record** link to record the new announcement.

Be sure to have your announcements scripted and ready. To begin the recording, click **Record** on the right. We recommend that you use a headset when creating recordings for better sound quality.

When you are ready to record, click **Record**.

When finished, click **Stop**.

To review your recording, click **Play**. Remember to save your recording. If a key has been assigned to play an announcement without recording the announcement first, you will receive an error warning.

When finished with all recordings, return to the Main page to turn your Easy Attendant on (see [Turning Your Easy Attendant On/Off](#)).

Optionally, you can record announcements from any telephone (see [Creating Announcements in Single Menu Mode](#)). You can also upload pre-recorded announcements (see [Uploading Announcements](#)). Select the dropdown next to the Record / Play Announcement option to change the method.

SWITCHING FROM SINGLE MODE + TO SCHEDULE MODE

You can easily switch between Single Menu Mode and Schedule Mode from the Main page.

Switch to single menu mode

If you switch to using a single menu, then all callers will hear the same menu irrespective of time or day. You can use one of your existing menus as the basis for this single menu.

The menu you choose not to use will be deleted, and you will lose all of its configuration and announcements. You will also lose your schedule configuration.

GETTING STARTED IN SCHEDULE MODE

+ FIRST TIME SETUP

The steps required to use your Easy Attendant are as follows:

- + Configure a weekly and holidays schedule, so that different menus can be played based for business and non-business hours.
- + Configure menus that callers are offered and the actions they can choose from.
- + Record the announcements that your callers will hear.
- + Manage the extensions that your callers can transfer to.

Your Easy Attendant will come pre-configured by Northland's System Administrator with the schedules and pre-defined menus you provided on the System Programming Form. You will need to record the actual announcements once you have your system (see [Creating Announcements in Schedule Mode](#)).

You will be able to make basic changes, such as adding holiday schedules and announcements yourself. You should have your Easy Attendant announcements documented for ease of recording (see [Sample Announcements](#) for sample scripts).

EASY ATTENDANT SCHEDULES

You can configure two Easy Attendant schedule periods.

FOR EXAMPLE: You can create a schedule for business hours and non-business hours schedule for when your business is closed. You can also create a holiday schedule or a schedule for "one off" days, such as inclement weather days or a company-wide retreat. The non-business hours announcement would play for holidays and one off days unless you re-record it.

For each schedule you create, configure the hours for each day from Monday to Sunday, when this schedule should apply. You do this by "coloring in" the grid by clicking on the appropriate cells. You can change several cells at once by clicking and dragging. Each schedule period is shown in a different color.

Use the following steps to change the hours of operation for any of the pre-defined schedules:

- + On the Schedule page, from the key at the bottom, choose which hours (business or non-business) you will be changing to.
- + Click and drag in the calendar to highlight the appropriate times.
- + When finished, click **Apply**.

To change the open hours to 8am to 5pm:

- + Select **Business Hours Menu**.
- + Click and drag the 8am to 9am, Monday through Friday blocks and they will turn blue.
- + When finished, click **Apply**.

HOLIDAY/SPECIAL DAYS SCHEDULES

The "Special Days" schedule covers public holidays and other special "one off" days when your business is closed. When you create a Special Days schedule, your non-Business hours announcement will play. Special days could include days that you are closed that are not public holidays for everyone, such as the day after Thanksgiving. They could also be days you are closed due to inclement weather or a company-wide meeting.

Configure days that will be your special days.

During special days, your Non-Business Hours menu will be active.

Click a date on the calendar to make it a special day, or click an existing special day to make it normal again. You can also click and drag to change several days at once.

Your Easy Attendant menu configuration determines the options your callers are offered, and what announcements they hear. The schedules and menus you provided to Northland Communications during the System Programming process will already be pre-defined in the Easy Attendant.

If you have chosen to offer different options during business hours and non-business hours, two separate menus will be configured: the "Business Hours Menu" and the "Non-Business Hours Menu." You can configure these menus using the corresponding tabs at the top of the Easy Attendant page.

The configuration of the Easy Attendant menu consists of the following:

- + First, configure the details of what should happen when a caller selects a particular option.
- + Then, record an initial greeting.

NOTE: The configuration of details is pre-defined based on the information you provided when you completed the System Programming Form.

To begin, navigate to the appropriate menu. You will see the options you chose already configured. You can edit or add additional options at any time.

Business Group Extensions are the list of lines within your Business Group. Configure which extensions are able to be dialed by callers as follows:

- + For each extension, you can select whether or not to include it in the list available to callers.

- + Any new lines added to the Business Group will automatically be included in or excluded from the set available to callers, based on the “Automatically include new extensions as they are added to the Business Group” setting.

Lines within the Business Group, which are available to callers, appear with a check in the “Included” column. These lines will automatically be available for caller actions.

To include selected lines in Dial by Name actions, you need to make sure that a name recording is available for that line. The name recording can come from one of two places:

- + You may record or upload a name recording by clicking on the record link for the line.
- + If a line already has a name recorded for voicemail, it can be used as the name recording for callers.

Lines using the voicemail spoken name have a green override link displayed. If you wish to record a Business Group name to be used in preference to the voicemail name, click the override link.

Lines with a Business Group spoken name recorded have a green listen/change link.

Lines that do not have a recording will have a red record link.
